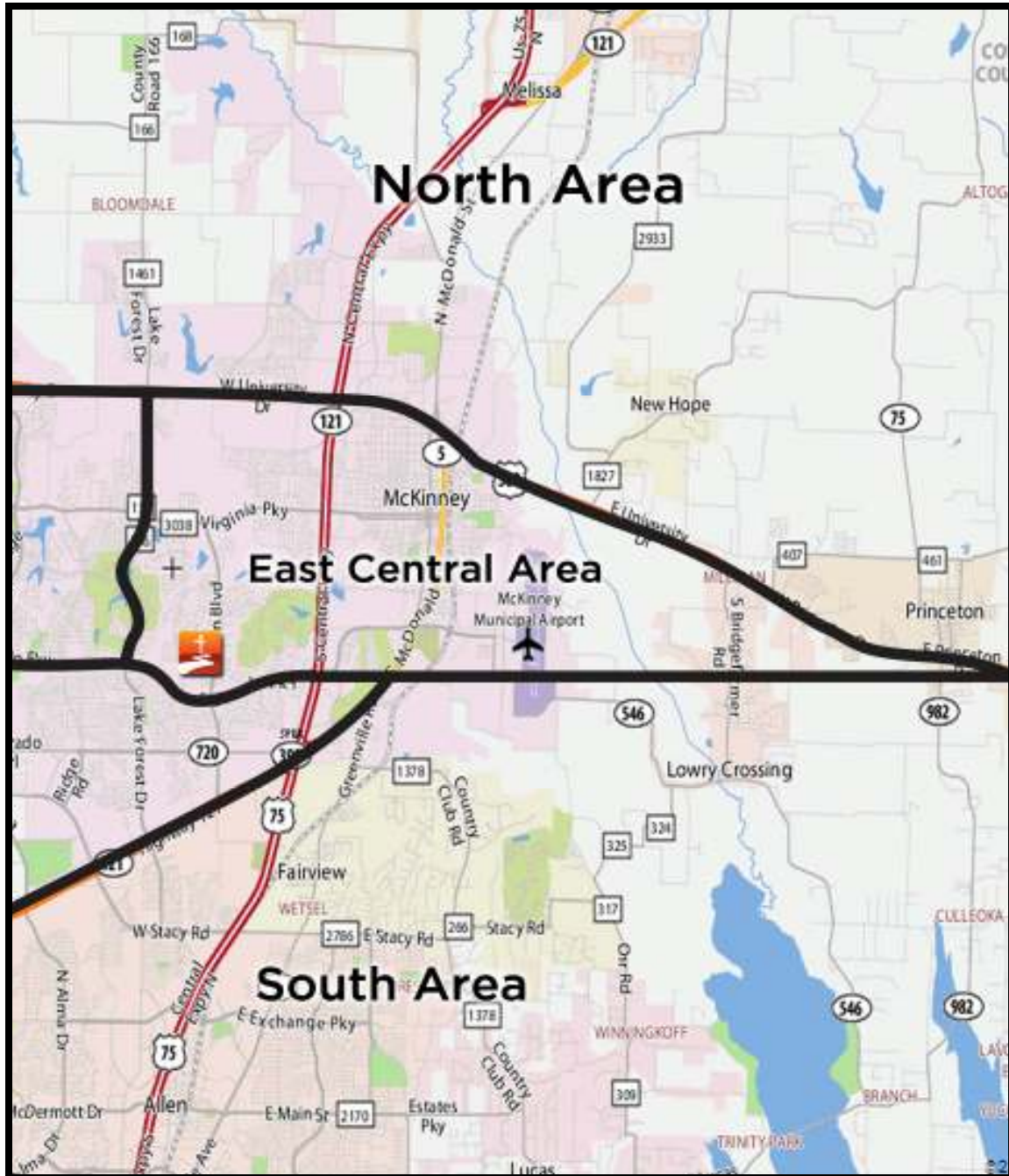

Group Childcare Options

Childcare issues often become a barrier to a parent's group involvement. We want to help alleviate any hindrance to your participation in a Life Group. Childcare may be handled in several ways. The following are two options provided by the church:

Subsidized On-Site Childcare at Christ Fellowship for Life Groups

1. Total cost is \$4 per child with a maximum of \$12 per family, per occurrence.
2. Nights available: Sunday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.
3. Must pre-register for on-site childcare at christfellowshipeldorado.com/childcare.

Subsidized Childcare Reimbursement Plan for Life Groups

1. Total cost may be as little as \$0 if you provide a babysitter at your home. Fill out a form for reimbursement at a fixed rate. The reimbursement form is available through the Groups section of our website at christfellowshipeldorado.com/groups.
2. The childcare reimbursement plan is only available for Life Groups.
3. The childcare reimbursement plan is not to be used for Christ Fellowship on-site childcare.

to have a relationship with us. Marvel at some of his most outstanding attributes. Explore each member of the Trinity. See how we're to properly respond to this loving God. The Bible study methods seminar is designed to compliment this Bible study group.

Jan. 24 - May 29, *U are the Church* is a study that reveals God's purpose, mission, and plan for the local church, and how he has uniquely designed each believer to participate fully in his work in the world. The authority of the Bible and Evangelism seminars are designed to complement this Bible study group.

Jan. 24 - May 29, *Apologetics* is a combined effort of Probe Ministries and CCBT (Centers of Church Based Training) to produce an apologetic study designed to help growing Christians to be able to give a reason for the hope we have, and a reasonable defense of the Christian faith. This is the beta testing for this new curriculum and will be a challenging study for any believer.

Jan. 24 - May 29, *Theology* (advanced) is an advanced systematic theology study using Wayne Grudem's Bible Doctrine book. You'll cover twelve theology issues looking at essential teachings of the Christian faith and be challenged each week biblically and philosophically. This is an advanced study with additional costs for Grudem's book. Cost is \$30 plus Grudem book.
